



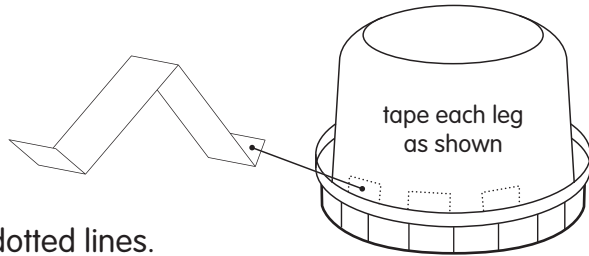
Make your own Box Tops collection container

It's easy...here's what you need:

- Scissors or craft knife (make sure children are supervised when using cutting tools!)
- Clear tape
- Crayons or markers
- One size small (16 fl oz) round Ziploc® Twist 'n Loc™ brand container

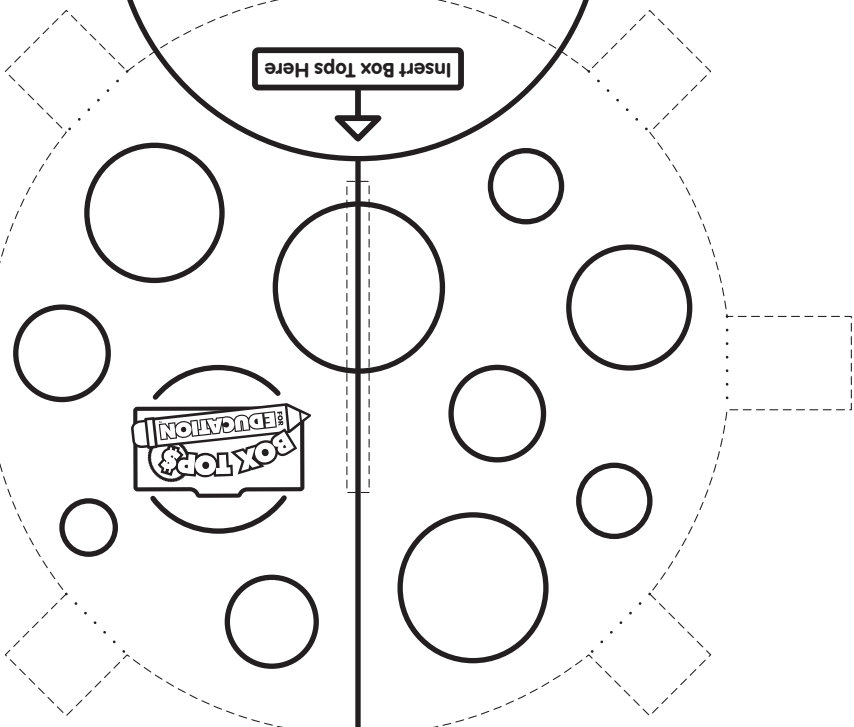
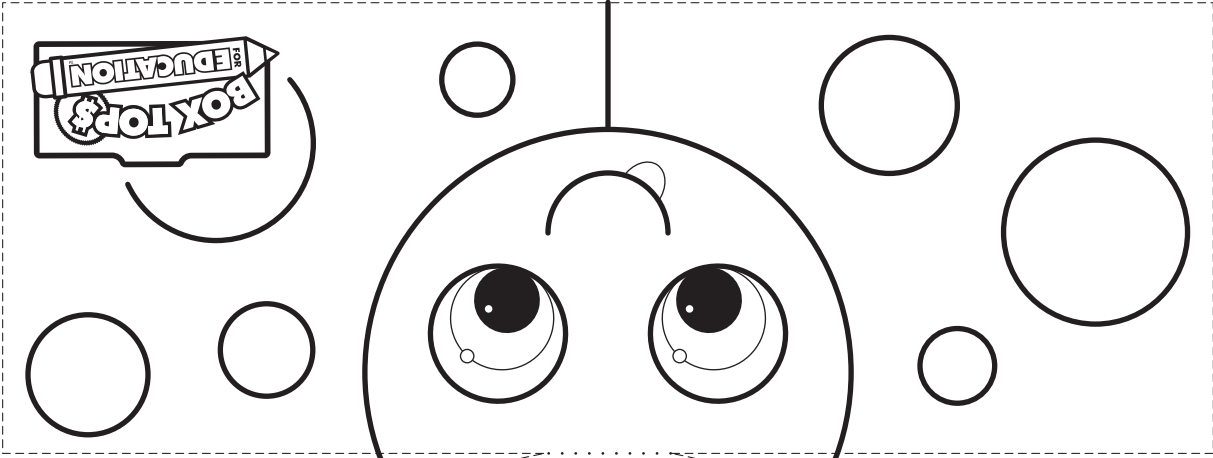
Directions:

1. Print out the collection project design.
2. Have your child color and decorate the design.
3. Cut along the dashed lines. Be sure not to cut the dotted lines.
4. Fold the legs along the dotted lines and tape three on each side of the container as shown in the diagram at the right.
5. Tape the center circular portion of the lady bug onto the bottom of the container using the six fold-down tabs.
6. Fold down the back flap of the lady bug and wrap it around the container. The legs should be taped low enough for this flap to overlap them. Secure with tape.
7. Repeat the step above with the front flap.
8. Where indicated, cut a slot in the container where you can insert Box Tops.
9. When it comes time to submit your Box Tops, just unscrew the lid!

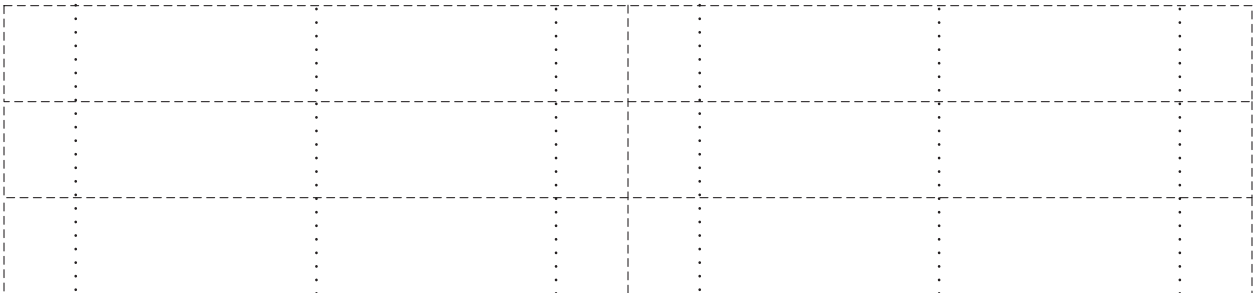
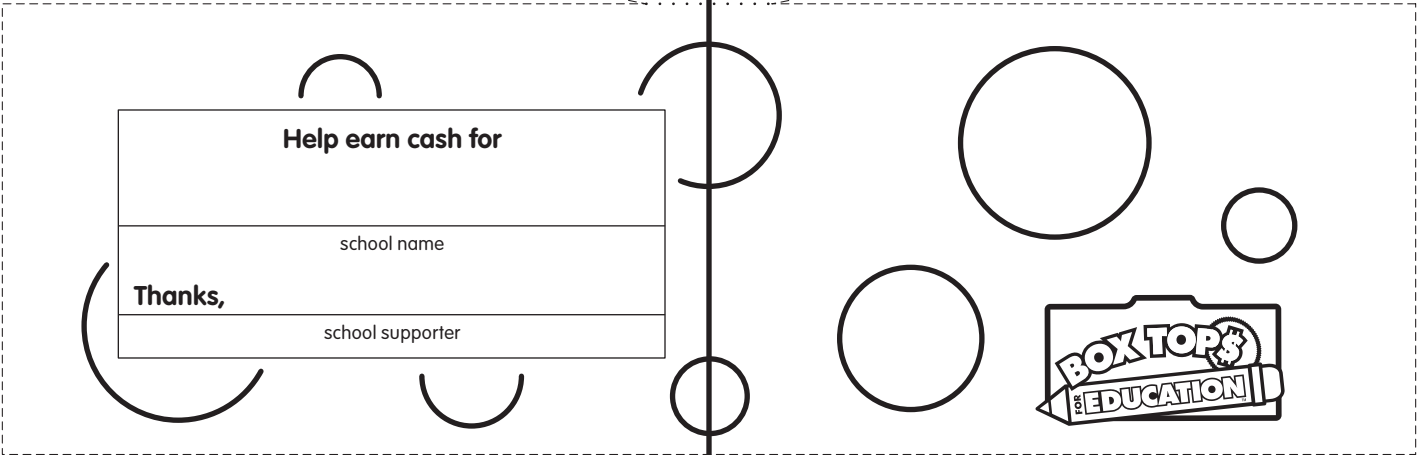
